

Information about the exam from the obligatory subject the FAPA (Functional and Pathological Anatomy) during examining period 25.5.-4.7. and 17.8.-31.8.2020 in the summer course LS 2020

To exam of the FAPA may sign in students who:

- complete the requirements for FAPA for summer course 2020 - thus, they successfully passed the lectures, practicals and pretests in Moodle. The exam shall be done in written form. The student sign in to the term stated in the AIS. This information is valid for regular students of the 1st year study and for students who transfer obligatory subject FAPA (it means for those students, who last year did not complete successfully the subject of Anatomy and physiology

or

- complete the requirements for the obligatory subject Anatomy and physiology, but did not pass the exam in 2019; and at the same time, has successfully completed requirements as well as exam of the obligatory subject Pathology (winter course ZS 2019 or summer course 2020). This option applies to students with transfer of obligatory subject of FAPA (it means for those who last year did not complete successfully the subject of Anatomy and Physiology).

Information about the exam from the obligatory subject Pathology

To exam Pathology may sign in students who:

- complete the requirements for Pathology exam in ZS 2020 – it means they successfully passed the lectures, practicals and pretests in Moodle, but did not pass the examination. The exam could be done in written form in summer course. The student sign in to the term stated in the AIS. This information is valid for regular students of the 2nd year of study and for those having obligatory subject Pathology in the 3rd or higher year of study

Notice: If it is the subject of the transfer, so the students have, within the academic year (ie. ZS+LS) only entitled to 1 ordinary and 1 of the correction term.

To control the entry of the mark in the AIS it is the responsibility of each student.
