**Course Schedule:**

*Lectures: Monday at 10.15 – 12.00 a.m.,*

*Laboratory and practical classes: Wednesday, at 7.30 – 10.10 a.m.,*

**Course completion criteria:**

1. Meeting 100% attendance of all Lectures as well as Laboratory and practical classes  
In the case of **Excused absence** (which is limited up to 2 cases), the student may substitute their missed presence by a form of a written seminar work or examination from the missed topic (*upon decision made by the corresponding class teacher*).  
**Failure to meet the conditions will result in the exclusion of the student from the study or the loss of the opportunity to take the exam.**
2. Showing sufficiently demonstrated **readiness for classes** – upload the protocols of the ongoing work "at home", checked by teacher responsible for the topics.
3. Obligatory attendance of the two **control Pretests** via Moodle during the semester with the minimum **60% passing score of correct answers per each on-line test** (Pretest I: conducted during the 6th week from topics of the week 1st-5th (20 multiple-choice questions of 6 possible answers with time limit set to 30 min, average 1,5 min per question) and Pretest II: conducted during the 12th week from topics of the week 6th-11th (24 multiple-choice questions of 6 possible answers with time limit set to 36 min, average 1,5 min per question, the content of the questions is based on class content (theoretical background and practical manuals).
4. Pretest failure shall be repeated by a Resit Pretest. Maximum of 2 Resit Pretests are allowed per each failed Pretest. The details of Resit Pretests will be posted in the Moodle system for all students at the same time. The Pretest results will be reflected in the AIS-e.
5. Successful completion rate and dates of the Pretests shall be reflected in the AIS by the teacher responsible for the course by the end of the last educational week of the semester.

## **The examination**

takes place in correspondence tuition (in written form) in the term announced via Moodle as the e-learning tool by the CU Bratislava. **Student shall register for the exam test as per available dates provided by AIS.**

The final **examination test** has 40 questions (from all topics as per syllabus of lectures and practical exercises of the entire semester), multiple-choice question of 6 possible answers, of which 1 or more is correct with time limit set up to 60 minutes. A successful outcome of the test (passing rate of **60%**, which is the evaluation of the E) is recognized as the ordinary term. The teacher will enter the result of the test in AIS within 48 hours.

*(Mark and score: A 91-100%, B 81-90%, C 71-80%, D 66-70%, E 60-65%, FX less than 60%).*

**According to the valid directives a student is entitled to 1. Ordinary and up to 2. Resit options.** The student has the voluntary option of "**additional trial test**" in the period of **8.5.2021 – 30.6.2021** (dates will be given by teachers in the AIS).

In case of **transferred subject**, the student is entitled to 1 Ordinary term and 1 Resit option only. Dates will be provided in the AIS not later than 7.5.2020, unless additional dates are provided subsequently. Students shall apply for selected date of examination within period of 8.5.2021 – 30.6.2021.

**Student, who failed the course completion criteria in this summer semester, shall transfer the course to the next year, and must attend the entire course in a full extent (lectures, practicals) to meet the course completion criteria in the next academic year.**

**Students, who passed the course completion criteria however fail the final examination test in this summer semester, shall transfer the course to the next year, and will undergo final examination test only.**

**Student is obliged to control that the mark is recorded in the AIS by the teacher.**
