

Requirements for credits acquisition: **Master study – Systemic and Pathological Physiology (SAPP)** **2021/2022**

Educational period: 20.9.2021 – 11.12.2021

Credits granting: 13.12.2021 – 17.12.2021

Examination period: 03.01.2022 – 11.02.2022

Form of education: combined (distance and presence)

The form of teaching and the content of syllables may vary on the basis of the current epidemiological situation as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

All forms of teaching will take place within the timetable for the subject.

Distance form of education will require **communication media: Teams for Microsoft, Moodle.**

Technical support with media: PharmDr. S. Kosírová, PharmDr. T. Rajtík

Lectures: are carried out in a form of **on-line presence (distance)**. The underlying materials are provided on Moodle (<https://uniba.sk/en/elearning/>).

Practical training: in the obligatory courses of the study program pharmacy are carried out in a **presence form within the timetable in dedicated rooms** (K105B).

At the beginning of the semester, each student will only sign once a „Written declaration of the student on compliance with the applicable epidemiological precaution“. The teacher will archive this sheet of paper until the end of the examination period of the given semester (11.02.2022).

The content of the laboratory classes has several parts:

Theoretical preparation for laboratory exercises is composed of parts Repetition and theoretical part presents self-study on the above topics and a short examination of students by the teacher. The source of information is recommended literature and underlying materials available in Moodle (<https://uniba.sk/en/elearning/>).

The practical part, including symptomatology, will be taught in a **presence form** in person according to the instructions of the teachers.

Course completion criteria:

1. Meeting 100% attendance of all lectures as well as laboratory and practical classes. In the case of **Excused absence** (which is limited up to 2 cases), the student may substitute their missed presence by a form of a written seminar work from the missed topic (*upon decision made by the corresponding class teacher*). **Failure to meet the conditions will result in the exclusion of the student from the study or the loss of the opportunity to take the exam.**
2. Showing sufficiently demonstrated **readiness for classes**, checked by teacher responsible for the topics.
3. Obligatory attendance of the two **control Pretests** via Moodle during the semester with the minimum **60% passing score of correct answers per each on-line test**. Pretest I: conducted during the 6th week from topics of the week 1st-5th and Pretest II: conducted during the 11th week from topics of the week 6th-10th; the content of the questions is based on class content (theoretical background and practical manuals). The results of the tests expressed in % will be given in Moodle and registered in the AIS.

4. Pretest failure shall be repeated by a resit pretest. Maximum of 2 resit pretests are allowed per each failed Pretest. **No more exceptions.** The details of Resit Pretests will be posted in the Moodle system for all students at the same time. The Pretest results will be reflected in the AIS and Moodle.
5. Successful completion rate and dates of the Pretests shall be reflected in the AIS by the teacher responsible for the course by the end of the last educational week of the semester.

The examination

takes place on line in the terms announced via e-learning tool Moodle **According to the valid directives a student is entitled to 1. Ordinary and up to 2. Resit options.** Exam dates will be entered by teacher in the AIS by 3.12.2021. Students register themselves and register for the date in AIS from 4.12.2021 to **11.02.2022.** **The fulfillment of the course conditions is checked by the Moodle application that allows student write the examination test (examtest).**

A successful outcome of the final **examination test** (passing rate of **60%**, which is the evaluation of the E) is recognized as the ordinary term. The teacher will enter the result of the test in AIS within next 48 hours.

(Mark and score: A=91-100%, B=81-90%, C=71-80%, D=66-70%, E=60-65%, FX less than 60%).

Student, who failed the course completion criteria in this summer semester, shall transfer the course to the next year, and must attend the entire course in a full extent (lectures, practicals) to meet the course completion criteria in the next academic year.

Students, who passed the course completion criteria however fail the final examination test in this summer semester, shall transfer the course to the next year, and will undergo final examination test only. In case of transferred subject, the student is entitled to 1 Ordinary term and 1 Resit option only to pass examtest.

Student is obliged to control that the mark is recorded in the AIS by the teacher.
