<b>Course requirements:</b> active participation on seminars, two semester tests with the overall grade at least 60%, written and oral exam scale of assessment (preliminary/final): 15% / 85%	
<b>Learning outcomes:</b> At the end of the course, students can understand the terminology correctly and use it in acquiring knowledge and practice within their field. Professional medical terminology includes mainly terms of the Latin and Greek origin used in medicine. Anatomical, pathological terms. Acquired information about specialized terms and their development helps students orient themselves to their field and understand their specialisation in the broader social and historical context, especially with increasing overall knowledge.	
<b>Class syllabus:</b> The teaching concept is pragmatically oriented so that students are broadly prepared for the challenging requirements of its future pharmaceutical practice. Teaching is primarily focused on ensuring that students will thoroughly master medical vocabulary as well as basic grammar phenomena (i. e. verbal flexion) that are necessary for a proper understanding of terminology. With the same goal, they will acquire the basics of word formation; rules applicable to the creation of professional terms.
