

COURSE SYLLABUS

Latin medical terminology

1 Week

Introduction to the Latin language. A brief historical overview. The position of the Latin language among Romance languages. Pronunciation, basic grammatical terms, declension of nouns, declension overview, structure of multi-word terms.

2 Week

First Latin and Greek declension. Adjectives of the first declension.

3 Week

Second Latin and Greek declension. Adjectives of the second declension.

4 Week

Nouns of the third declension and adjectives of the first and second declension, abbreviations and eponyms. Third declension - consonant stems. Third declension – vowel stems: masculine and feminine gender. Third Declension - vowel stems: neuter gender.

5 Week

Fourth and fifth declension.

6 Week

Adjectives of the third declension. Comparison of adjectives. Third declension - Greek nouns - continuation, clinical terms with endings -itis, -osis, -oma.

7 Week

Numerals and verb forms in medical terminology. Grammatical structure of medical prescriptions and prescription examples. Practice writing prescriptions.

8 Week

Latin and Greek prefixes. Greek words in medical terminology.

9 Week

Latin and Greek suffixes. Adaptation of Greek disease names. Adverbs in medical terminology.

10 Week

Compound words in medical terminology. International classification of diseases, diagnoses of individual diseases and their Latin names.

11 Week

Pathological-anatomical diagnosis, examples. Hippocratic Oath. Final revision, Latin memorabilia.

12 Week

Pathological-anatomical diagnoses in medical practice. Examples of diagnoses, grammatical and terminological analysis.
